Place Accra Ridge Church (Interdenominational), Gamel Abdul Nasser Road

Theme 'That the World May Know' (John 17:23)

Participants Leaders from all the major streams of world Christianity. Half of them

from the 'older' Churches (Anglican, Catholic, Orthodox, Protestant)

and half from the 'younger' Churches (Evangelical, Pentecostal,

Independent). Giving special attention to the inclusion of youths, women,

and leaders of migrant and megachurches.

Purpose To meet across denominational, regional, national, ethnic and cultural

boundaries so That the World May Know we are one in Christ. To such

effect, the gathering will provide plenty opportunities for church leaders to inspire one another and exchange insights on matters of

common concern.

Hosts Representatives of national churches and organizations in Ghana will

accompany preparations for the gathering, welcome international

participants to it, and participate actively with them in it.

Costs Global Gathering participants are requested to cover cost of their travel

and hotel accommodation. Please refer to the 'Hotel Information'

document for options and costs. In addition, participants are expected to make a participation contribution to help defray gathering costs (including meeting facilities, interpretation, meals, airport shuttle on April 15 & 20, daily transportation to venues, materials, learning tour within Accra and on

the coast). The amount of the participation contribution will range from

USD550 to USD750 according to global region.

resources out of solidarity with churches globally.
